

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1018, AS REPORTED**OFFERED BY MR. Chaffetz**

Section 8, strike paragraph (2) (page 17, lines 4 through 11) and insert the following new paragraph:

1 (2) by striking “Governments” and all that fol-
2 lows through “management.” and inserting “Gov-
3 ernments and shall include two representatives of
4 the livestock industry; two representatives from
5 State grazing boards (or equivalent State agency)
6 who are not State employees; two representatives of
7 the environmental community; two representatives of
8 the animal protection community; two representa-
9 tives of Indian tribes who manage wild horses or
10 burros; and four scientists. All advisory board mem-
11 bers must have expertise in wildlife management,
12 rangeland management, animal husbandry or nat-
13 ural resources management and must reside in
14 States comprising the current range of wild free-
15 roaming horses and burros.”; and
