

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1
OFFERED BY MS. EDDIE BERNICE JOHNSON OF
TEXAS

Page 112, line 22, after the colon insert the following: “*Provided further*, That \$125,000,000 shall be for historic preservation projects on the campuses of historically black colleges and universities pursuant to section 507 of the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-333), except that the Secretary of the Interior shall waive the requirement in section 507(e)(2):”.

Page 183, strike lines 1 through 3 and insert the following:

- 1 (i) The institution is eligible for Fed-
2 eral assistance under part A of title III,
3 【section 316(b)(3), section 317 (b)(2), sec-
4 tion 317 (b)(3), section 318 (b)(1), section
5 319, section 320】 【These are all in part
6 A. And what about part B?】, or Title V of
7 the Higher Education Act of 1965, includ-
8 ing public and private institutions, except
9 that institutions shall not receive an award

1 under both subsection (c) and subsection
2 (d) of this section in the same fiscal year.

Page 190—

(1) on line 15, strike “containing” and insert
“containing—”; and

(2) beginning on line 15, strike “a compilation
of” and all that follows through the period on line
17, and insert the following:

3 (A) all of the reports under paragraph (1)
4 submitted to the agency by institutions of high-
5 er education; and

6 (B) a summary of the amounts awarded to
7 institutions described in subsection (c)(1)(C),
8 particularly those eligible under **【Part B**
9 **【They aren’t even included in (C)(1)(c) any-**
10 **more after your change to page 183, lines 1-3.】**
11 of title III of the Higher Education Act of
12 1965.

Page 191, line 2, before the period insert “and para-
graph (2)(B)”.

Page 184, after line 2, insert the following new sub-
section (and redesignate the succeeding subsections ac-
cordingly):

1 (d) AWARDS TO HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES
2 AND UNIVERSITIES AND OTHER MINORITY-SERVING IN-
3 STITUTIONS.—【To be edited】

4 (1) Grants, contracts and cooperative Agree-
5 ments shall be entered into with eligible institutions
6 authorized to receive funds under the Minority Insti-
7 tutions Digital and Wireless Technology Opportunity
8 Act of 2008 (122 Stat. 3474) in an amount which
9 is not less than \$250,000,000;

10 (2) Grants and contracts shall be entered into
11 by the National Science Foundation pursuant to the
12 Course, Curriculum and Laboratory Improvement
13 (CCLI) Program (Stat.) with institutions eligible
14 to receive funds under section 316 (b)(3), section
15 317 (b)(2) and 317 (b)(3), section 318 (b)(1), sec-
16 tion 319, section 320, and section 322(2), and Title
17 V of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amend-
18 ed, in an amount not less than \$100,000,000, except
19 that any otherwise eligible institution that receives
20 funds under the Act of March 2, 1867 shall not re-
21 ceive funds under this provision and that Act in the
22 same fiscal year;

23 (3) Provide \$10,200,000 to the Secretary of
24 Education to carry out the provisions of the HBCU
25 Capital Financing Program (122 Stat. 3181) to

1 guarantee an additional \$61 million in loans cur-
2 rently in the pipeline;

3 (4) Authorize any historically black college or
4 university and any eligible minority-serving institu-
5 tion, eligible to receive assistance under Title III or
6 Title V of the Higher Education Act, as amended,
7 that receives an award under subsection (d) to use
8 such funds to carry out any of the activities in sub-
9 section (e); and

10 (5) Reduce the amount appropriated to carry
11 out section 9302 by the total of the amounts stated
12 in paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) to carry out sub-
13 section (d).
