**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ROGERS OF KENTUCKY**

Page 15, after line 7, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1115. EXPENDITURE PLAN.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Of the discretionary funds made  
3 available in this Act, 50 percent shall not be available for  
4 obligation until the Director of the Office of Management  
5 and Budget submits to the Committees on Appropriations  
6 of the House of Representatives and the Senate an ex-  
7 penditure plan for a program for economic recovery and  
8 reinvestment that—

9 (1) includes a complete accounting of all funds  
10 made available in this Act, aggregated by each dis-  
11 crete expenditure, and including a description, pur-  
12 pose, location, total cost, projected date of execution,  
13 and projected timeline for implementation and com-  
14 pletion for each program, project, or activity sup-  
15 ported by each expenditure;

16 (2) explicitly describes how each expenditure  
17 will further the goals and objectives of section 3 of  
18 this Act;

19 (3) includes an identification of staffing, includ-  
20 ing full-time equivalents, contractors, and detailees,

1 for each agency required to meet the requirements  
2 and objectives of sections 1201, 1202, 1203, 1204,  
3 1221, and 1225 of this Act; and

4 (4) a certification that the requirements of sec-  
5 tions 1221, 1226, and 1229 of this Act are met.

6 (b) REPORT ON DISCRETIONARY FUNDS WITHHELD  
7 FROM OBLIGATION.—Not later than 5 days after the en-  
8 actment of this Act, the Director of the Office of Manage-  
9 ment and Budget shall submit to the Committees on Ap-  
10 propriations of the House of Representatives and the Sen-  
11 ate a report specifying by account, and by program,  
12 project, or activity, each amount of discretionary funds  
13 that will be withheld from obligation pursuant to this sec-  
14 tion.

15 (c) COORDINATION OF PROVISIONS.—For purposes  
16 of the application of section 1103 of this Act, discretionary  
17 funds withheld from obligation pursuant to this section  
18 shall be considered appropriations not available upon en-  
19 actment.
