

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3326, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SESSIONS OF TEXAS

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1 **TITLE X—ADDITIONAL GENERAL PROVISIONS**

2 SEC. 1001. Not later than 60 days after the date of
3 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall
4 submit to Congress a report on the use of hyperbaric oxy-
5 gen therapy (in this section referred to as “HBOT”)
6 under the Secretary of Defense. Such report shall include
7 the following:

8 (1) The number of members of the Armed
9 Forces, veterans, and civilians being treated with
10 HBOT.

11 (2) The types of conditions being treated with
12 HBOT and the respective success rates for each con-
13 dition.

14 (3) The current inventory of all hyperbaric
15 chambers being used by the Secretary of Defense
16 (including the locations, the purposes, and the rate
17 of use of such chambers).

18 (4) Any plans for expanding the use of HBOT
19 for treatment.

1 (5) An analysis of the use of HBOT at the
2 Centers of Excellence for Psychological Health and
3 Traumatic Brain Injury, including—

4 (A) the Defense and Veterans Brain Injury
5 Center;

6 (B) the Center for Deployment Psychology;

7 (C) the Deployment Health Clinical Cen-
8 ter;

9 (D) the Center for the Study of Traumatic
10 Stress;

11 (E) the National Center for Telehealth and
12 Technology;

13 (F) the National Intrepid Center of Excel-
14 lence; and

15 (G) other locations the Secretary of De-
16 fense considers appropriate.
